Pre-Katrina NORD

Budget and Staff Information

- NORD's Pre-Katrina budget was \$8.7 Million
- The department operated with 250 employees

Facilities Operational

- 150 Playgrounds and play spots
- 19 Swimming pools 3 indoor & 16 outdoor
- 10 Multipurpose centers
- 4 Baseball stadiums
- 1 Football stadium
- 1 Theater
- 2 Senior centers

All NORD facilities withstood wind and/or flood damage due to the impact of Hurricane Katrina

Post-Katrina NORD

Following Katrina, NORD operated with a budget of \$985,705 and 16 employees

- Utilized a small facility at Annunciation Playground for office space
- Telephones, internet service, air conditioning and/or heating services were not accessible
- Accessed an estimated \$60 million in damages with assistance from FEMA
- 15 NORD playgrounds were used as trailer sites to housed displaced residents
- Larry Barabino Jr. was appointed the new Interim-Director in June 2006 to rehabilitate NORD's programs and facilities
- First order of business was to re-open 4 swimming pools, 8 playgrounds and one community center
- Also partnered with non-profit agencies to provide summer enrichment programs

NORD's Recovery

- In 2007 NORD re-opened 52 playgrounds and play spots
- In 2007, NORD operated with less than 40% of its centers, playgrounds and swimming facilities.
- Currently, the department continues to work with limited resources
 - 17 Active playgrounds with sports teams
 - 35 Passive for community usage
 - Successful youth basketball, baseball and volleyball seasons
 - After school tutorial programs in partnerships with JOB1 and Dillard University
 - Successful ballet, tap, jazz and modern dance classes in partnership with NOBA
 - Served, Over 1,500 youth ages 5 to 14 participating in youth football
 - Providing music programs (vocal, instrumental and piano lessons)
 - Adult and senior fitness programs

The Progress Continues

NORD has re-opened 62 Playgrounds and play spots throughout the City

- 22 active playgrounds with sports teams
- 40 passive for community usage
- Successful youth basketball, baseball and volleyball seasons
- After school tutorial programs in partnerships with JOB1, UNO and Dillard University
- Successful ballet, tap, jazz and modern dance classes in partnership with NOBA
- Currently Serving, Over 2,300 youth ages 5 to 14 participating in youth footh
- Providing music programs (vocal, instrumental and piano lessons)
- Arts & crafts and ceramics programs
- Adult and senior fitness programs

 7 Swimming pools city-wide in Partnership with American Red Cross



 Provided summer camp programs for over 5,000 Youth in partnerships with the Police and Justice Foundation (Cops For Kids), Operation Reach, Tambourine & Fan, Catholic Charities and the Recovery School District.







The Progress Continues

NORD Priorities:

- Managing 23 "quick hit project" playground field lights, fencing, tennis courts and basketball court
- Focus for 2009 includes the repair of additional playgrounds/facilities and programs

Current Types of repairs underway

- Repairs to playground & stadium field lighting and electrical systems
- Replacement of equipment and sports teams' uniforms
- Renovations to tennis courts









Next Steps

- Work with FEMA to re-access NORD facilities and project worksheet values
- Complete the restoration of 15 NORD playgrounds used as FEMA trailer sites
- Re-staff facilities and restart additional programs
- Provide educational, recreational and cultural activities for city youth
- Create and continue to build partnerships with corporate, faith-based, non-profit and community-based organizations
- Re-establish senior citizens activities and programs
